

Things you should know before you start

1. What is the difference between Release_a/b and Release_part1/2
 - Release_a/b denote different datasets from the same center. There could for instance be a difference in TR or the number of volumes. Unless indicated these datasets are collected on the same magnet.
 - Release_part1/part2 indicates different parts of the same dataset. In this case the data for this center were split to keep the file size of the archive reasonable.
2. Each release includes a subject list.
(Release_subjects.txt)
3. If available the release includes a document indicating age and sex for each subject.
(Release_demographics.txt)
4. Where needed peculiarities about the release are indicated in Release_readme.txt
5. In case of multiple parts in a Release, the above documents (2,3,4) are included in Release_part1.
