Things you should know before you start

- 1. What is the difference between Release_a/b and Release part1/2
 - Release_a/b denote different datasets from the same center. There could for instance be a difference in TR or the number of volumes. Unless indicated these datasets are collected on the same magnet.
 - Release_part1/part2 indicates different parts of the same dataset. In this case the data for this center were split to keep the file size of the archive reasonable.
- 2. Each release includes a subject list.
 (Release subjects.txt)
- 3. If available the release includes a document indicating age and sex for each subject. (Release demographics.txt)
- 4. Where needed peculiarities about the release are indicated in Release readme.txt
- 5. In case of multiple parts in a Release, the above documents (2,3,4) are included in Release part1.
